2. Collaborated with Churches, Community Leaders, and National Disaster Relief Organizations to help rebuild our community.
3. Coached and shared our experiences with other communities through disasters including tornadoes, floods, and hurricanes.
4. Builds hope by providing pathways to homeownership to those homes who were lost or destroyed in a disaster. This is a pay it forward program that multiplies the generosity given towards those who were directly affected by a disaster.
5. The Hope Initiative is one part of the recovery process and prioritizes the need for your recovery being a locally led effort.
