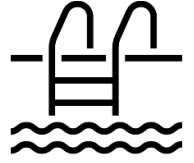

Site Plan Diagram. Site plan must show the site property boundaries, structures on site, location of either proposed or existing fence, and layout of the pool, including mechanical devices for the pool, i.e., pump equipment.

All residential pools, hot tubs, and hydro spas must conform to the requirements found in the International Swimming Pool and Spa Code and City of Douglas Code of Ordinances.

- Applicant is responsible for contacting 811 to have underground utilities marked prior to beginning any work for the pool.
- All above-ground or in-ground swimming pools shall be installed no closer than ten (10) feet to any property line and principal buildings measured from the nearest water surface, exclusive of the decking, which shall be located no closer than five (5) feet from any property line and principal building; swimming pools shall be located in the rear or non-street yard of the property.
- All pools having a depth of eighteen (18) inches or greater at the deepest point shall be enclosed by a fence or wall of not less than four (4) feet in height with locks forty-eight (48) inches from the ground on any gates on the fence. The fence or wall shall be designed so that a four (4.0) inch diameter sphere cannot pass through any opening.
- All gates or doors opening through such fence or wall shall have self-closing and self-latching devices that keep the gate or door closed at all times when not in actual use. Operable windows and doors in the portion of the structure being used as a barrier must have an audible alarm indicating the window or door has been opened.
- An electrical permit must be pulled by the pool company or the licensed electrician performing electrical work **and** a bonding inspection must be performed before cover-up.

I certify that I have read this application and state that the above information is correct, and agree not to start the proposed project until this application has been approved and I have received a permit card. I certify that I have the authority to request and sign for this permit as, or on behalf of, the property owner. I agree to comply with the laws of the state and the zoning regulations established by the City of Douglas, and any violation of these will cause immediate revocation of the permit.
